Happy Fathers' Day

Today we honour our Fathers. And that's a good thing! Sometimes maybe Dads don't get as much respect as they genuinely deserve.

A doting Father used to sing his little children to sleep. He even learned a few lullabies to lend some variety to the task. This was something he could do at night to help his wife out.

And he kept up this task until one night he overheard his four-year-old give her younger brother this advice, "If you pretend you're asleep," she said, "he stops singing. Poor Dad, sure he hasn't a note in his head" That was the end of the lullabies!

Jesus once described the kingdom of God in this way:

"This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how . . ."

Now Jesus is not talking about fatherhood in this passage, but isn't this the very first area in which we participate in the coming of God's kingdom to earth? It is in the raising of our children. The raising of good children is like scattering good seed upon the ground for the spread, the growth and the flourishment of God's Family and here on earth....
