The Good Samaritan

We have several ideas in our minds about this scene and the story Jesus told to bring out in a concrete situation his teaching.

The first is that the message of the Good Samaritan is that one should be a decent person and help anyone in need. This is a valid and important point but that is not the mes-sage here.

Then, second, we think of the hypocrisy of the priest and the Levite who were the public face of religion, and hypocrisy in professional religious is especially loath-some, so it is a warning about preaching and not practising. Again, this is a valid and important point but that is not the message here.

Then, third, we tend to make the message of Jesus here the same as that of the Golden Rule – 'do as you would have others do onto you' – which is the basis of many codes of morality and which is found in the gospels - 'And as you wish that men would do to you, do so to them'. Yet again, this is a valid and important point but that is not the message here.

The story is not about how to treat others in a passive sense; it is to draw out that the call to inherit eternal life is the call to love others. This is a deliberate act of reaching out to others in need. And the question then becomes how far can you ex-pect to reach out and from how far away can you accept the reach of love.
