New Heating System For St John's

All funds raised at the Three Tenors Concert will go towards the new heating system of St John's Church plant room. Needless to say, much more funds are required to foot the bill for this essential upgrade.

Any and all donations would be most welcome!

The work is currently well underway and should be ready for commissioning by the end of the month. The old system, which was 36 years old, was giving endless trouble and was causing a lot of wasteful expense. Engineers, who decommissioned it as a fire-risk, estimate that it was operating at only 40% efficiently, max; whereas the new, much smaller condenser boiler operates at 96% efficiency.

Unfortunately, our application for the 50% grant from SEAI for conversation to gas was rejected, even from the highest levels. Consequently we were forced to remain with an oil-fired system as the complete cost of converting to gas was prohibitive. M & D Fennelly are the contractors, and we extend our prayers and sympathies to Michael & Dermot who interred their brother, Brendan R.I.P. this Saturday.
