On Friday just gone, 28th February, we received guidelines from the HSE regarding safe practice in our churches regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, and we are pleased to take immediate action. The main points:

- ♦ If you feel ill, stay away from religious services;
- Practice good hand and respiratory hygiene at all times;
- ♦All hard surfaces frequently touched to be cleaned regularly;
- The 'Sign of Peace' to be suspended;
- Holy water fonts emptied and not to be used;
- Holy Communion to be given into the hands only NOT on the tongue;

• Sharing of the Chalice (e.g. with Euch. Ministers) to be suspended.
