#### Lent – a Time of Renewal and Growth

As we approach the Season of Lent – a traditional and powerful time of renewal and growth – we might look at our Mass attendance. In a pastoral letter issued this weekend Cardinal Nichols of Westminster, wrote "The highest form of prayer is the celebration of the Eucharist. It is here, above all other places, that the Lord wishes to fill us with his gifts, so that we, in turn, can offer those gifts to others."

Lent comes as a rallying call for all of us to reflect on our attitude to Mass. For some the thirst for being at Mass and for celebrating life-giving sacraments has diminished over the past two years. This Lent is the time of grace when we can usefully reflect on our commitment to the weekly celebration of the Eucharist. The Season of Lent provides the "time for a fresh start, the time to reset our patterns."

Cardinal Nichols also invited us to reach out to our family members and friends who do not attend Mass any more. "I would like you to be ready to approach those whom you know, and who are not present here today, with a word of invitation for them to join us." This should be done with great diffidence and kindness. "Do what you can to invite those who are missing to come with you to be part of this great family of faith and prayer."

Fast from worries and have trust in God.


Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.
