## Pope's Travel Plans Postponed

Pope Francis' July trip to the African countries of the Democratic Republic of Congo and South Sudan has been postponed for health reasons, the Vatican said on Friday.

"At the request of his doctors, and in order not to jeopardize the results of the therapy that he is undergoing for his knee, the Holy Father has been forced to postpone, with regret, his Apostolic Journey to the Democratic Republic of Congo and to South Sudan," Vatican spokesman Matteo Bruni said on 10<sup>th</sup> June. The trip, planned for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> July will be moved "to a later date to be determined," the statement said. Pope Francis was planning to spend 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> July in the Congolese cities of Kinshasa and Goma, and 5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> July in the South Sudanese capital Juba.

Let us pray for Pope Francis who, these days, is using a wheelchair to help with his mobility.

### **The Most Holy Trinity**

Theologians describe the inner life of the Trinity with a Greek word meaning 'to dance around'. This word conveys something of what the inner life of God is like – a life whose essence is a dynamic love exchanged by the Father, Son and Spirit. And if we imagine this life of God as a circle then we believe that God has opened the circle of his own life in order to embrace us into it. This is why St. Irenaeus described the Son and the Holy Spirit as the 'arms of the Father' that embrace us and all creation into his own life. In the words of Julian of Norwich, we are 'embraced by the Father, embraced by the Son and embraced by the Spirit'. This image of being embraced into God's very life challenges any distant or cold image of God we might have. As St John reminds us in his Gospel, He is in us, but we are also in him'.
