We are called to go forth, to be an evangelising community, even if that simply means opening the front door of our homes and stepping out into our own neighbourhoods... For a disciple of Jesus no neighbour can become distant. On the contrary, there are no distant people who are too far removed, but only neighbours to reach out to. God does not wait for us to go to him but it is he who moves towards us. This is what God is like. What does this mean for us? It means that this is our road too. Following Jesus means learning to come out of ourselves. (Pope Francis)

Food for Thought

The 'Anima Christi' ('Soul of Christ') prayer is often recited by individuals after receiving Communion. The prayer appears in the opening words of St. Ignatius of Loyola's Spiritual Exercises and is often attributed to St. Ignatius, but the prayer was widely known in the 15th century, and several 14th century manuscripts contain the prayer. The author of the prayer is unknown. Franciscan Father Jack Wintz writes that 'this sacred prayer is sublime and seems to transcend all time, all centuries.' 'With the Spirit's help, the words of the prayer can lead us into union with Christ,' he says.

Try reciting the prayer the next time you receive Communion.
