Fr Billy did his doctorate on the writings of St Patrick and so this promises to be an interesting evening of reflection. This event will take place on this coming Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> March in St Kieran's College at 7.30pm. All are very welcome to attend.

## St. Kieran - Our Diocesan Patron Saint

The feast of St. Kieran - patron saint of the Diocese of Ossory - is celebrated on, 5<sup>th</sup> March. His mother came from Cape Clear in Co. Cork, his father from Ossory. Kieran was one of the pre-Patrician saints of Ireland. Traditions say he went to Rome, was ordained by the Pope and was sent back to Ireland by Patrick. He is called 'the Elder' to distinguish him from St. Ciarán of Clonmacnoise.

After the penal times, in 1782, Bishop John Thomas Troy of Ossory (later Archbishop of Dublin) established a Catholic diocesan seminary, St Kieran's College, in Kilkenny. The motto he gave it was: *Hiems transiit*, a quotation from the Song of Songs which means Winter is Passed and applied it to the passing of the winter of the Penal Laws in Ireland. When the diocesan cathedral was built in 1843, although it was called St. Mary's, it also has Kieran as its secondary patron. This weekend we call upon St. Kieran to pray for our diocese and our new bishop.

The *Kilkenny People* carried the news on the front page of the paper the following week with a photograph showing a temporary altar that was erected under the tower. The celebrant was Rev Timmy O'Connor, Dean, St Kieran's College; Deacon Rev Sean Doherty, Sub-Deacon, Rev Pierce Malone, Master of Ceremonies, Rev Pat Duggan.
