Gaudete Sunday

This Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent, is also known as Gaudete Sunday. The word 'gaudete' is Latin for 'rejoice' which is the first word of the Entrance Antiphon of this Sunday's Mass: 'Gaudete in Domino semper: iterum dico, Gaudete.' This means 'Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, rejoice.'

This is why on this Sunday we focus and contemplate upon the aspect of 'Joy' in Advent, after that of 'Hope' and 'Peace' in the earlier two Sundays of Advent and 'Love' in the next and final Sunday of Advent. This Sunday, much like its Lenten counterpart, the Laetare Sunday, marks a short and temporary break from the penitential and more sombre nature of the rest of the Advent Season, as we prepare and anticipate the coming true Joy of Christmas.
