What Happened this Week in the Church in Ireland?

In what has been described as the most significant reorganization of the Church in Ireland in 800 years the Holy Father, through the Papal Nuncio Archbishop Luis Mariano Montemayor, announced changes in the dioceses in the west of Ireland, the ecclesiastical province of Tu-am. The Archbishop of Tuam will now also be the bishop of Killala and the Bishop of Elphin (Sligo) will be bishop of the diocese of Achonry.

The Papal Nuncio to Ireland said the seismic changes were needed to meet "new challenges" facing the Church, "pooling resources" to increase vitality.

"Although we seek to preserve at all times our essential identity, we adopt measures to meet new challenges as they arise," said Archbishop Montemayor. However, a full merger will take place "if this process evolves still further", so that the six dioceses would become three, Archbishop Montemayor said. "They say 'in union there is strength'. Thus, with pooled resources and combined endeavours, and trusting strongly in the grace of God, we can look to the future with hope and confidence."

St. Lasarian

Our neighbours in the diocese of Kildare and Leighlin celebrate the feast of St. Lasarian (or Molaise) on Thursday of this week. Lasarian was born in Ireland, became a monk on Iona, and studied under and was ordained priest in Rome by St. Gregory the Great. Returning to Ireland, he took over an already established monastery from St. Gobban at Leighlin, Co Carlow, of which he became abbot a few years before his death. He was a strong proponent of the Roman method of determining the precise date for the celebration of Easter in the Church liturgical calendar. Under Lasarian, Leighlin became a strong centre of support of the Roman method of calculation of Easter. It is said that Leighlin was the first place to adopt the new date for Easter. Laserian at that time was in charge of 1500 monks and he defended and implemented the order regarding Easter from Rome.
