Points to Ponder on Today's Gospel

In this Sunday's Gospel story the men who brought the woman to Jesus saw her only in terms of her immediate past, while being blind to their own past. Jesus' way of looking at her was very different; he saw the whole picture of her life, not just one little bit of it. Seeing the whole picture of her life, he also saw that she had a future as well as a past, a future that those who brought her to him would have denied her.

When the Lord looks at us, he sees the whole picture too; he does not become obsessed with one or two dark details of the picture. The Lord is attentive to the full story of our lives not just to a couple of lines of that story. He also knows that the story of our lives is always an unfinished story. It is the Lord himself who will endeavour to write the final chapter of that story when, in the words of Paul's letter to the Philippians, he will come from heaven to transfigure our lowly bodies into copies of his own glorious body. Speaking through the Prophet Jeremiah, the Lord says, 'I know the plans I have for you, the plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future full of hope.'

The Lord offered the woman, and offers all of us a future full of hope.' He can offer us such a future because, again in the words of Paul his power at work within is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all we can ask or imagine.'

Streets of Kilkenny 5k Road Race (Road Closures) - 17/04/2024

St. John's Parish has been informed that many streets in the vicinity of St. John's Church will be closed with permission from Kilkenny County Council and the Gardai from 6.45pm to 9.30pm on Holy Thursday, 17th April 2025 to facilitate a road race organised by Kilkenny City Harriers.

St. Francis Bridge, CAS Link Road, Castlecomer New Road, Hebron Road Roundabout and John's Street will be closed to traffic, effectively restricting traffic on Michael Street, Maudlin Street, Wolf Tone Street, Ballybought Street and the Hebron Road. Carparks regularly used by church goers at John's Green, Wolf Tone Street and the Carnegie Library will also be closed. Regretfully, this means the only vehicular access to St. John's Church for the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening will be via O'Loughlin Road and the Dublin Road from the Ring Road Roundabout.

Parishioners are asked to note these prohibitions when planning your journey to St. John's Church for the Mass of the Lord's Supper - one of the most important celebrations in the Catholic calendar. Please leave home in plenty of time and be prepared to walk some distance to church.
