Bishop Coll Translated to Raphoe

We were all surprised and disappointed on Thursday morning when Pope Leo announced the appointment of Bishop Niall Coll as the next bishop of Raphoe. A native of Donegal Bishop Coll was ordained for his home diocese in 1988 and having been Bishop of Ossory since 2023 now returns to his native soil. He will continue to be Administrator of the Diocese of Ossory until his installation as Bishop of Raphoe. We prayerfully bid him adieu and wish him well in the land of St. Eunan and St. Columcille – his experience here in Ossory will serve him well as he shepherds the people of Co. Donegal.

The translation of a bishop from one diocese to another is not new for the Diocese of Ossory; Bishop Dermot Farrell was appointed Archbishop of Dublin in 2021 after less than three years as Bishop of Ossory; after 13 years in Ossory Bishop Patrick Moran moved to Sydney as Cardinal Archbishop in 1884.

Bishop Coll was our bishop for three years but some of his predecessors' tenure here were shorter – many, as in the case of Bishop Coll, because they were translated to another diocese. By comparison many of his predecessors were bishop of the diocese for decades: Abraham Brownrigg was bishop for 44 years, Patrick Collier for 36 years, Peter Birch for 17 years and Laurence Forristal for 26 years.

World Day of the Poor

The World Day of the Poor is uniquely a celebration within the Church, celebrated on the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time. Established by Pope Francis in 2016 the theme of the first year in 2017 was "Let us love, not with words but with deeds."

This year Pope Leo has declared Sunday, 16th November to be the ninth World Day of the Poor, with the theme of "You are my hope" - the theme taken from the Psalmist's cry "You, O Lord, are my hope" (Ps 71:5), reflecting also the Jubilee Year of Hope.

In his message for this World Day of the Poor, the Holy Father urges us to recognise those experiencing poverty as "witnesses to a strong and steadfast hope, precisely because they embody it in the midst of uncertainty, poverty, instability and marginalisation." The poor are not a distraction for the Church, but our beloved brothers and sisters, for by their lives, their words and their wisdom, they put us in contact with the truth of the Gospel.

Pope Leo goes to Nicaea

The Creed, which we recite at Mass every Sunday, is 1700 years old this year. It was written at the Council of Nicaea in 325AD.

Pope Leo will visit Nicaea during an Apostolic visit to Turkey and Lebanon later this month to celebrate the 1,700th anniversary of the Council and the Creed. He will meet civic leaders and bishops, priests, deacons, consecrated men and women and pastoral workers at Istanbul's Cathedral of the Holy Spirit on Friday, 28th November. Later that day he will travel to Nicaea - approximately 100 km from Istanbul - where he will participate in an ecumenical prayer service and give an address on the site where the council took place. On Saturday, 29th Pope Leo XIV and the Orthodox Patriarch Bartholomew I will sign a joint declaration.

On 30th November, the Feast of St Andrew, the Pope will travel to Beirut where he will meet various civic and religious leaders, visit local important religious sites, celebrate Mass and visit local hospitals. Let us pray that this will be a fruitful journey.
